Ventura Freeway West (134)

Exit Hollywood Way. Turn left onto Alameda Ave. from exit. Turn left at Pass Ave. Turn right onto Olive Ave. Turn Right onto Lakeside Drive. Continue one block to Gatehouse.

Hollywood Freeway North (101)

Exit Barham Blvd. / Burbank. Proceed north on Cahuenga Blvd. from exit. Turn right onto Barham Blvd. (Barham becomes Olive Ave.). Turn left onto Lakeside Drive. Continue one block to Gatehouse.

Hollywood Freeway South (101)

Merge onto the 134 east. Exit Pass Ave. Turn right onto Pass Ave. Turn right onto Olive Ave. Turn right onto Lakeside Drive. Continue one block to Gatehouse.

San Diego Freeway North (405)

Merge onto 101 East toward Los Angeles. Proceed to 134 east. Exit Pass Ave. Turn right onto Pass Ave. Turn right onto Olive Ave. Turn right onto Lakeside Drive. Continue one block to Gatehouse.

Lakeside Golf Club of Hollywood

Opened 100 years ago in 1924, Lakeside Golf Club is Hollywood's "home course" and features Max Behr's masterwork as its centerpiece. In 1933, famed golf architect Dr. Alister MacKenzie, whose designs include Augusta National and Cypress Point, described Lakeside as "one of the world's greatest golf courses" and the "best" course in Southern California. Golf greats, screen legends and so many great amateurs have spent their days enjoying the Lakeside experience. We think you will agree with golf legend Walter Hagen who called Lakeside "the finest, most enjoyable golf in the West."

Upon Arrival

Whether you are a golf, social or dining guest, the security attendant or valet will direct you to self or valet parking and advise you where to go once your car is parked. All golf guests should proceed directly to the Golf Shop or adjacent Starter Shack after parking their vehicle.

Golf Customs, Traditions, and Rules

Lakeside Golf Club takes great pride in the Club's enduring and historic caddie program. The Club firmly believes that golf is best experienced by walking with a caddie and should not take more than three hours and forty-five minutes to play, regardless of the number of players in a group. Golfers must ensure that all ball marks are repaired, divots are replaced or filled, and bunkers are raked.

Attire

Shirts must be collared or mock-turtleneck and always tucked in. Club or Hawaiian style shirts with a squared-off bottom hem are allowed to be worn untucked at appropriate social events. Collarless shirts, tank tops, hoodies, baggy clothing, and any clothing with large, non-golf club or clothing brand logos are not permitted. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Cargo, cut-off, or gym shorts are not permitted. Jeans or denim pants of any type or color are not permitted. All hats and visors must be removed in all Clubhouse areas except the locker rooms and must be worn forward, not sideways or backwards.

Cell Phones

The use of cell phones for phone calls in the Clubhouse, adjoining premises including the Kelly Garden, putting green or driving range is prohibited. Cell phones may be used on the golf course for any purpose except for phone calls when on hole #1, #9 and #18. If using a cell phone for phone calls on the golf course, please be mindful of other golfers. Audible rings are never allowed. Discrete text and email is permitted.

Social Media

Dissemination through social media of personal photographs or videos identifying Lakeside Golf Club is not permitted. In addition, the publication for commercial purposes of any pictures taken anywhere on the Club's property identifying Lakeside is not permitted. Any written references to Lakeside Golf Club, its Members, activities, and practices that are or might become accessible by the public is not permitted. This includes hashtags, comments, posts, location check-ins, and similar identifiers. Members and guests of the Club may not discuss the Club's Membership, events, policies, rules, by-laws, or activities using social or professional media platforms.

Reclaimed Water

For the past 20+ years Lakeside Golf Club has utilized reclaimed water to irrigate the golf course and grounds. The scientific community has repeatedly documented that reclaimed water is very safe for human exposure and its utilization is essential to address the growing demand and diminishing supply of potable drinking water.
